## <u>Staffing</u>

A letter outlining the staffing for next session will be issued on Tuesday and the children will be informed by their existing teachers of the plans for next session.

Our advert for a new Business manager is going live this week. We will be interviewing in a fortnight.

#### **PSA Allocations**

I have been in touch with the authority regarding the formula for allocating PSAs and am awaiting the response.

## **Empowered Learning**

All P6 and P7 children have received their individual I-pads. They are beginning to explore the uses of these to enhance their learning.

Our Wi-Fi should be getting upgraded soon 😉

We have our allocation of group I-pads for Primary 1-5 children, which will be ready to deploy in the new term

#### **Pupil Equity Funding**

Each year we are allocated additional funding for all children who, have applied for and, are entitled to Free school meals or live in SIMD 1 or 2.

This funding allows us to access additional resources to close the poverty related attainment gap and offer wider experiences.

This year I plan to use the funding to fund additional staffing- SfL teacher time, PSA support and PSO post.

Additional resourcing to promote and enhance play-based learning and invest in additional Reading resources.
